

These rims need refurbishing and painting. Not bent. Last used on Datsun PL510. Will fit Toyota Corolla of similar vintage (1970-1980).

SET No 2.

Qty.4, Shelby Alloy rims, 5.5" wide.

2.69" hole in centre of rim, offset about 0.31"

These rims have 5 "kidney-shaped" slots and require special nuts for mounting to car. Have sufficient nuts available with M12x1.25 thread Will fit Datsun PL510. or similar.

SET No 3. Qty 4 Alloy rims, 6.25" wide

4 mounting holes on 113.5 P.C.D.

2.56" diam hole in centre, offset about 0.44"

These rims have 5 "kidney-shaped" slots, and require special nuts for mounting to car. Have sufficient nuts available with M12x1.25 thread.

Rims are currently fitted with Dunlop 195/70SR13 "For Rally Use only" tyres, which are absolutely shot. If you buy the rims you get the tyres too.

These rims were last used on Datsun PL510.

Entry fee is \$25 per event per team. MLRC and TAC members pay \$20 per event per team.




