**Max Mosley now has unfettered control of Formula One as president of the FIA. Up to 31st December 2007 Formula One was a democracy – not any more**

It made the sport focus on the immense power that has been vested in one man and his ability to virtually do what he likes. But how did Max Mosley achieve it and persuade people to hand him so much power in a major profile of the president.
