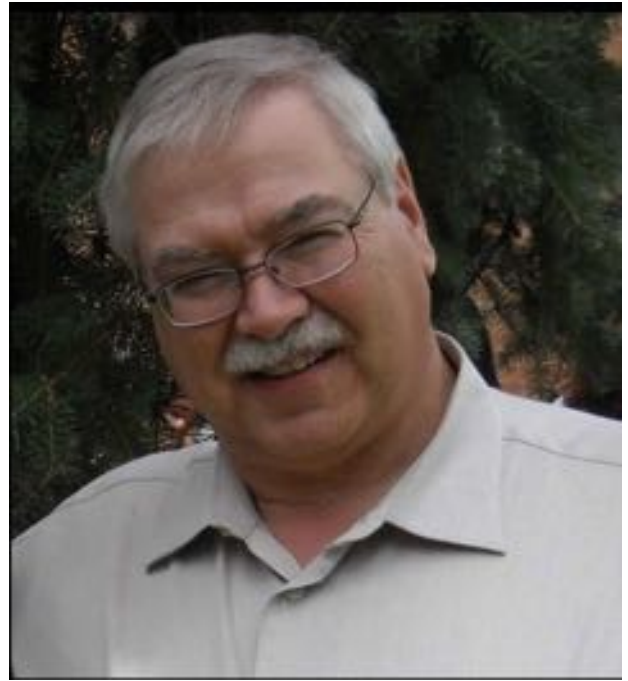

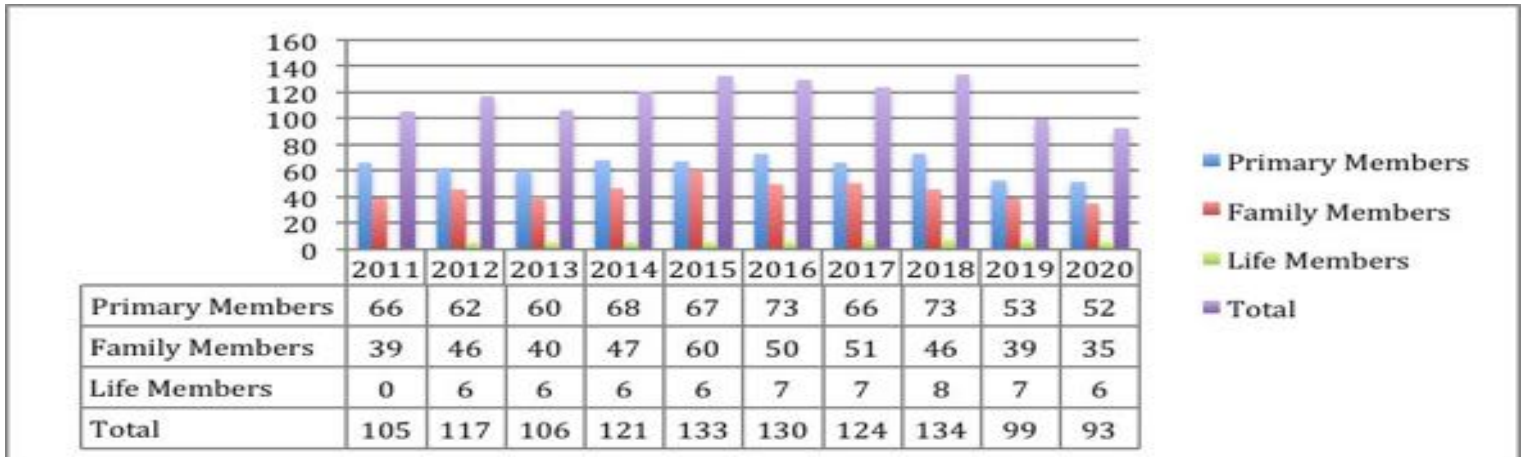
Dave always carried a positive attitude and was a pleasure to know and work with. Many will miss him.

### COVID-19

Unfortunately in March a global COVID-19 pandemic was declared and although we didn't know it at the time, the balance of the 2020 season events would eventually be forced to cancel.

Cancelled events included:

- Pacific Forest Rally
- Rallye Défi
- Lincoln Electric Rally of the Tall Pines
- Big White Winter Rally

In October the CARS board decided to cancel the 2020 championship leaving only the re-scheduled Rocky Mountain Rally that still planned to run.

After cancellation of the season Rocky changed to a regional event, then a couple of weeks before the event was to take place, and with worsening Alberta COVID cases that event also cancelled.

## CARS Rule changes in 2020

---



### **Bulletin 2020-01 - Administrative Rule Changes**

Included updates to helmet standards, eliminated the Media Licence, clarified the use of in-town stages and corrected a translation error in the French rule book.

### **Bulletin 2020-02 & 04 - Spectator area jumps and Rally Sprint course design**

Improved precautions at spectator jumps and restricted the use of artificial/manufactured spectator jumps. Changed RallySprint speed limit from the average competitor speed to the median competitor speed.

### **Bulletin 2020-03 - Anti-Lag and Launch control on production class cars.**

Clarified that Anti-Lag and Launch Control are only allowed if those features are available as OEM.

### **Bulletin 2020-05 - Administrative rule changes removing reference to ASN Canada FIA Inc**

Removed references to the old ASN company name.

### **Bulletin 2020-06 - Changes to Rally Sprint rules**

This change addressed a discrepancy in the translation in the French rule book.

## CARS 2020 Goals

### PROMOTION & SPONSORSHIP

1. Start work on the 2021 - 23 Subaru contract (2020 season cancelled has delayed all discussion about next contract)
2. Continue search for other advertisers and supporters to allow for increase in TV coverage to 8 events (no progress this year since no TV was available)
3. Maintain CRC promotional material updated with latest exposure/viewership data ready for use with prospective sponsors and for updating existing sponsors. 100%
4. Work with the regions and events to develop promotional material for the combined CRC, ECRC, WCRC, NARC and stand-alone regional championships. No Progress
5. Develop and maintain targeted promotional packages aimed at specific sponsorship levels and types of company. 50%

## CARS 2020 Goals

1. Work with events to make the most use of our communications channels to advertise and promote all CARS sanctioned events. (very little activity in 2020 due to pandemic)
2. Generate income in excess of that needed to fund the promotional and broadcast material, allowing for selective growth and improvement related spending in accordance with the capital plan. (barely breaking even)
3. Encourage new & existing competitors to rally;
  - I. Increase overall entry levels through better promotion of the sport.
  - II. Promote Rally Cross events.

  - V. Develop Rallysport info graphic communication tool
4. Help CRC events gain from the promotional assistance provided by CARS;
  - I. Providing on-stage advertising space to ensure online and TV exposure.
  - II. Help reduce cost to events by encouraging the leveraging of the media product.
