TAC Annual General Meeting – time for renewal?

If you're reading this, I look forward to seeing you next Wednesday, at the AGM.

Every TAC member needs to make an effort to be present because I think it is time to have some serious discussions about where our club is going, and about our objectives.

As a grey-haired geezer, I know why I got involved with the Canadian Timing Association and the St. Clair Motor Sport Club, back when the Earth was cooling. And as a long-term TAC member, I'm glad to have served for six years on our Executive.

BUT. Things have changed a lot, and I'm no longer as informed – or as involved – in competition as I used to be.

So I'm looking forward to hearing the Directors' Reports, and to understanding where TAC is going to put its emphasis for the next five years.

And I'm also looking forward to meeting the younger members who are going to fill the Executive slots that are currently open, and take TAC forward with renewed energy, effort, and vision.

Incentive Program

Lewis Hamilton has an extra incentive spurring him on whenever he goes to the factory. There is a rare McLaren F1 road car sitting there that Ron Dennis promised would be his if he won three titles.

"Whenever I walk past it, I don't even think my girlfriend gets the same look, bless her heart," he smiled. "She's definitely got a challenger there. I love that car, always loved it. "I've stared at it for God knows how many years, and there is always something new to stare at." FYI, the McLaren F1 carried a \$1M price tag when it was launched...

F1 Medical:

There is one vital member in every F1 team who is always quietly busy with — the team doctor. With hot weather conditions prevalent in places like Abu Dhabi, the team doctor becomes crucial for the success of the team.

According to Dr Ricardo Cecarrelli, Toyota's team doctor, Formula One racing is a highly demanding sport, especially on the heart. "The average heart rate of a driver is around 180 beats per minute which the driver has to sustain for one and a half hours. No other sport keeps a heart rate so high for such a long time," he says.

Besides, F1 cars also put a heavy workload on the entire body. With G forces coming into play at every corner and along each straight, the neck muscles get constantly battered. Just keeping the car stable on the track requires lot of strength. "A normal person could only do two or three laps in a Formula 1 car under those stresses," Dr Cecarrelli says.

Excess heat, according to Dr Ceccarelli, doesn't allow the body to work properly. "As the body temperature goes up, your brain, muscle and reactions suffer. Sweating is the body's cooling system so you also lose fluids through sweat," he says.

He feels that the best way to combat heat is to drink lots of water with some minerals. The next important thing is nutrition. "It is best to eat simple food which is easy to digest; fruit and vegetables are the best things to eat.

Formula One is not only an intense physical activity. The drivers have to cope up with tremendous mental workload as well.

"Formula 1 is a sport where the brain has to be working hard for the whole race. In tennis, you have a break every few seconds, in boxing you break every three minutes, in shooting you break all the time. When you compare a Formula 1 driver's brain to an average person, the way it works, is completely different," he says.
