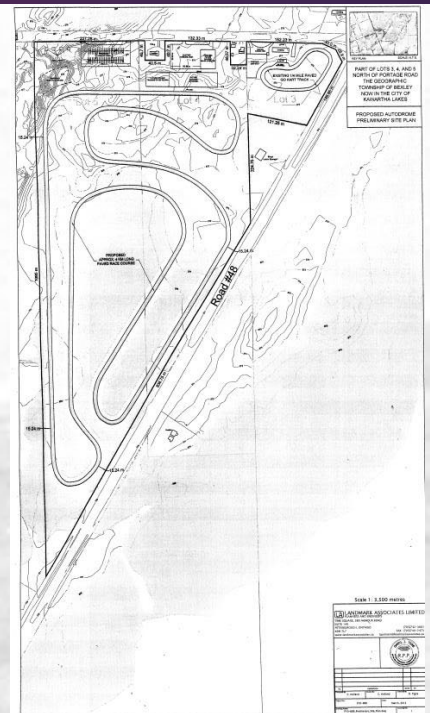

# TREASURER'S ANNUAL REPORT Nov 1, 2019

Well after several disappointing or downright poor years, the club finally had a year in which things went well for us! Net income was better than we've seen in over a decade, and we ended up \$2553.25 better than we started 2019. So here's what was different this year:

There was a significant reduction in the production costs for our great newsletter Fifth Gear, as a majority of members choose to receive it via email rather than a mailed, paper copy. We had somewhat better numbers from the CTMP Barbeque weekend, making this expense smaller than last year. Contract rally income was back to normal, after waiving the fee for one of the rallies in 2018 due to an error in organization. Social Director Fred did a great job of managing the annual Awards Banquet last December, and we saved a few hundred dollars while still having a nice private room for our party.

On the other hand, we did have a fairly large expense having to replenish our sticker supply – but that will last us for years now.

The best news of the year for TAC's bank account was the Ice Race. For once, we had a weekend with perfect racing weather! Nothing was cancelled, and our event fell mid-season so just about everyone who was going to race was out there doing it (we were between the "my car isn't ready yet" and the "I've wrecked my car and won't be back this season"! ) Coupled with those lucky factors, we also were able to rein in our expenses compared to previous years, by limiting compensation of the high-end hotel rooms, among other measures. You would think that hotels in the Minden area would be very eager to please winter customers like us, but it would seem that, price-wise, some are taking advantage of ice racers. So I think our volunteers were more conscious of that this time.

In spite of the good news, I think we need to notice that the membership dues income was \$1000 less this year than in 2018. Where is everybody? We can't count on perfect conditions at one single racing event to carry us through the entire year; we need membership dues. This is something everyone should be thinking about and trying to find solutions for. Recruitment is definitely one approach; but perhaps it is also time to think about raising the membership dues. \$50 a year for the entire family is a number that hasn't changed in about 20 years! It is still a much better deal than most other options; but would an extra \$5 per family really cause us to lose anyone?

In conclusion, it was a year that allowed our bank accounts to breathe a sigh of relief! Here's to 2020!
